


# **Byford Health Hub** – Program Governance

# The Byford Health Hub Program has formal oversight, to ensure it runs well

Any major government program has formal requirements for how planning is managed and decisions are made, to ensure that public money is spent appropriately, and the work achieves what it sets out to. The groups and process that manage this is called 'governance' (who 'governs' what goes on).
