#### Overview

The EMHS Moorditj Wirrin Koolangkas (MWK) Program supports Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander youth to express Creativity, Culture, and Connection to Country through Artwork inspired by the Six Nyungar Seasons. Selected pieces will feature in MWK resources and promotional materials.

#### Artwork Submission Guidelines

- Schools must be within the Perth Metropolitan area.
- Artwork must be created by Aboriginal and/ or Torres Strait Islander students aged 10–18.
- Each student must complete an parent/guardian consent form.
- Any medium is allowed (paint, digital, drawing, collage, mixed media).
- Artwork must be original and inspired by the Six Nyungar Seasons.

#### Permitted Uses

The Artwork may be used by EMHS for the following purposes:

- Promoting the MWK Program.
- Included in MWK educational and community health promotion materials.
- Displayed at MWK attended or supported youth and community events.

#### Prize Details

The winning school will receive a prize valued at up to **\$2,500**. To ensure the prize directly benefits Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students, the school may select **one** of the following four categories:

- Cultural experience or excursion.
- In-school cultural experience.
- Purchase of school equipment.
- Educational initiative.
